The cost for the lunch from the hotel is \$48.

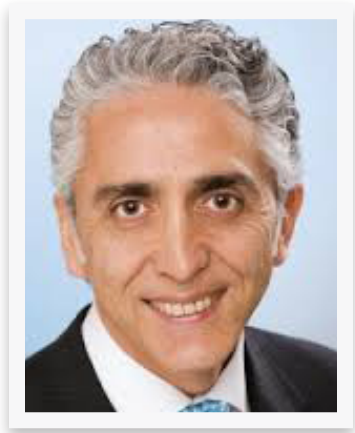

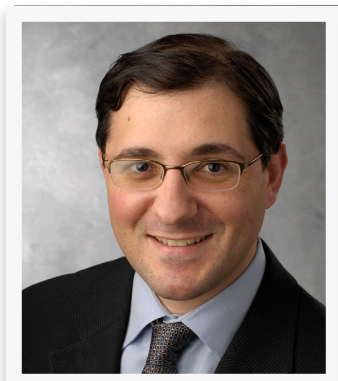

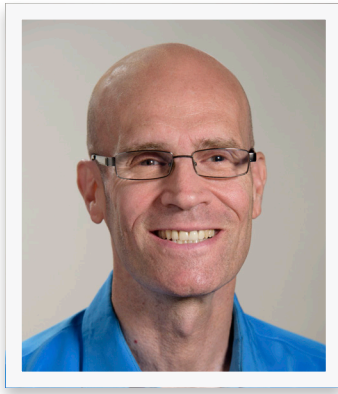
